Edmonton Pride Run Endowment


The Edmonton Pride Run Endowment will be used to support the Institute for Sexual Minority Studies and Services (iSMSS) at the direction and discretion of the Directors of iSMSS. Specific uses of the fund include, but are not limited to:

- salary and benefits for faculty members, teaching positions or staff positions;
- student financial assistance;
- support and enhancement to student programs, teaching, research, or any other project or initiative that will ensure excellence at iSMSS; and
- any other activity as deemed appropriate by the Directors of iSMSS.

iSMSS will be the account holder, and will establish administrative procedures for any new or additional activities as necessary. Procedures and expenditures will be in accordance with the spending and financial policies of the University of Alberta. The Directors of iSMSS will have joint decision making authority on expenditures and will take responsibility for ensuring the expenditures support the goals and vision of iSMSS. The Dean of Education or designate will provide the one-over-one approval.

The purpose or purposes to which the annual spending allocation is utilized will be reviewed by iSMSS at least once every five (5) years, with a view to modifying the utilization of the spending allocation as per the needs and priorities of iSMSS. Any modifications to the allocation of spending will remain consistent with the trust terms.

These terms represent how the University of Alberta, as Trustee, intends to describe, publish, and administer this fund. If in the future it becomes necessary, advisable, or preferable for changes to be made to these terms, in doing so, the University will remain governed by the original intent as expressed at the time of the creation of this fund.
